Like the canary in a coal mine, abortion rights in America are a focus of U.S. women s status in society as it fluctuates between that of chattel to full equality. The book can be read as a case study of social change, both from a societal perspective and from an individual woman s perspective. It is a study of anti-women discrimination and prejudicial behavior from not only a societal but also from a personal perspective. It also opens an insider s view of the character and upbringing that motivated the author s role in advancing social change and the motivation and tactics used by those who seem to prefer a mediaeval view of society. The daily struggle of dealing with employees, medical service providers, patients and abortion opponents who all seem to revel in making life difficult punctuates a story that includes actions on the national stage that defined abortion rights through the 1980s....
